CALL TO ORDER

With a quorum of Council Members present, the Meeting was called to order at 5:35 PM by Barbara Fisher, Bayside Property Services Ltd.

PREVIOUS MINUTES

After discussion, it was moved, seconded (Losorelli/Reyes) and carried unanimously to approve the Minutes of the February 19th, 2008 Council Meeting as previously distributed by Bayside.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

1. Maintenance Report:

Bayside provided Council with a report on all of the outstanding maintenance items. Bayside is in regular contact with the contractors and the Council President with respect to the ongoing maintenance requirements at "Villa Montecito". The following are all the items that have been addressed since the last Council Meeting:

- a) Power washing (ongoing);
- b) North wall siding at 7353;
- c) #7 7315 ceiling repairs;
- d) 7357 roof installation (emergency work);
- e) #7 7355 bedrooms, ensuite bathroom and hall ceiling repairs;
- f) Electrical repairs at 7369 building;
- g) Raccoon and squirrel relocation;
- h) Installed three breezeway drains;
- i) Solid fence around pool area erected.

Kiddie Pool: The kiddie pool cannot be filled in at this time as it is connected to the big pool
as part of the pump system and cannot be blocked off. Council is reviewing other options
for dealing with the pool, but for now the pool will remain as it is.

FINANCIAL REPORTS

- Financial Reports: After review and discussion, it was moved, seconded (Fraser/Coleman) and carried unanimously to approve the January and February 2008 Financial Reports as prepared by Bayside.
- Accounts Receivable: Council reviewed the Accounts Receivable Report as at the date of this meeting. Following discussion, Council instructed Bayside to effect collection of all outstanding accounts, as necessary.

If you have received correspondence regarding overdue account balances, please contact Bayside immediately to discuss your overdue accounts.

NEW BUSINESS

- Street and Breezeway Lighting: Council is reviewing quotes for new lamps for the streets, and light fixtures for the breezeways. Many of the lights that are currently on the property are malfunctioning and require replacement. Finding new parts is not an option due to the age of the fixtures.
- Roof Vent Insulation: Council is reviewing ways in which to insulate ceiling roof vents that have a tendency to sweat. This item is ongoing and will be updated at the next regularly scheduled Council Meeting.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was terminated at 7:20 PM.

The next Council Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 15th, 2008 at 6:00 PM in the Cabana.
