STATUTORY PROTECTION

- (I) A residential builder or an owner builder and a vendor of a new home are both deemed to have agreed with the owner of the new home, to the extent of labour, materials and design supplied, used or arranged by the residential builder, owner builder or vendor, that the new home, except to the extent prescribed by regulation,
 - (a) is free from defects in materials and labour and will remain so for a period of at least 2 years after
 - (i) the date an occupancy permit with respect to the new home was first issued, or
 - (ii) if no occupancy permit has been issued with respect to the new home, the date the new home was first occupied,
 - (b) is free from defects in the building envelope, including defects resulting in water penetration, and will remain so for a period of at least 5 years after
 - (i) the date an occupancy permit with respect to the new home was first issued, or
 - (ii) if no occupancy permit has been issued with respect to the new home, the date the new home was first occupied, and
 - (c) is free from structural defects, and will remain so for a period of at least 10 years after
 - (i) the date an occupancy permit with respect to the new home was first issued, or
 - (ii) if no occupancy permit has been issued with respect to the new home, the date the new home was first occupied.
- (2) Any term of an agreement that purports to waive, exclude, limit or qualify the protection under subsection (1) is of no effect.
- (3) The protection under subsection (1) is for the benefit of whoever is the owner of the new home from time to time until the end of the period within which an action may be brought under subsection (5), and that owner is deemed

 - (c) subjects a municipality, regional district or treaty first nation to any greater liability than if this section were not in force.

About Blackie Spit Park

Blackie Spit Park is a stunning City park located in the Crescent Beach neighbourhood of South Surrey. The park is named after the dramatic spit that extends into Mud Bay at the mouth of the Nicomekl River. Blackie Spit has amazing views of Mud Bay and the north shore mountain. Blackie Spit also offers some of the best bird watching areas in Canada, with almost 200 species of birds recorded in a calendar year. The sandy spit, surrounded by tidal marsh and eelgrass beds, is an important stop for migrating and wintering waterfowl and shorebirds, as they make their way up and down the coastline of North and South America. Fall migrants start arriving in late August and September. Spring migrants start arriving in mid-March, and are generally gone by the end of May. Blackie Spit Park is also a great place to see aquatic mammals. Harbour seals and their pups love to rest on the sandbars. The Park is managed as a wildlife conservation area so habitat enhancement activities are ongoing throughout the park. The nature trail walk around Blackie Spit Park is around 5 kilometres long. Allow around 2 hours for this walk. Blackie Spit Park has signs throughout the park for a self-guided walk. Learn about the history and ecological significance of the area while enjoying the beautiful ocean views and wildlife. This waterfront park is also home to the Surrey Sailing Club, the Crescent Beach Swim Club and the Dunsmuir Community Gardens.

Blackie Spit Dog off-leash Area

Blackie Spit also has a fully fenced <u>dog off-leash area</u>, featuring a mixed terrain of grass, gravel and sand. The off-leash area is east of the main parking lot at McBride Avenue and Wickson Road, next to the tennis courts. Here, you'll find also a covered area for those rainy days when Rover still needs a run. Further to the north of the primary dog off-leash area, at the far north of the parking area, you'll find the Blackie Spit dog off-leash beach. This area of the beach is fully fenced in with a shoreline to explore and a swimming area for dogs. See the <u>Dog Off Leash Area & Swimming Beach Map</u> to see where to take Rover. Remember to use a leash when traveling between the main dog off-leash area and the beach area.

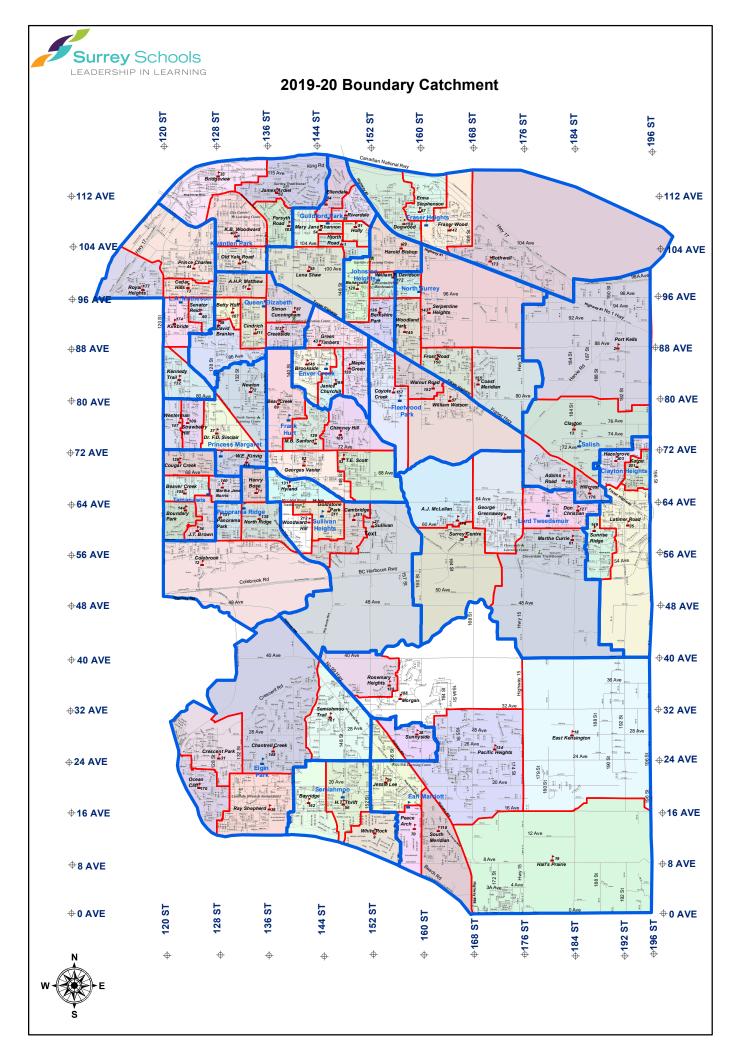
