HOME MAINTENANCE

Safety and security is also a consideration. Cracks in the chimney or exposed wiring present hazards that must be dealt with quickly. You should also know how to shut down all the systems in your home in case of an emergency or evacuation.

Learning about your home's systems will enable you to complete some maintenance tasks yourself. Often, though, the expertise of a specialist will be required, such as for furnace cleaning. For safety's sake, know when you have the skill to complete the task and when you should rely on a trained technician. 
