One of the greats of the New York City jazz and big band scenes, Cabell 'Cab' Calloway was a legendary fireball of talent whose infectious 'hi-di-his', scattin' and jivin' in a baritone singing voice rich and vibrant, became the spirited cry of people wanting to be happy.

The Cab Calloway Orchestra was the house band at Harlem's famed Cotton Club where he performed such iconic hits as Minnie the Moocher and Hi-de-ho Serenade. Calloway, was also credited with creating an art deco fashion craze called the zoot-suit.
