

This floor plan shows a townhome unit with a total area of 1,000 sq. ft. The layout includes:

- ENTRANCE:** Located at the top center, leading into the main living area.
- KITCHEN:** 6'-6" x 7'-4", featuring a sink, stove, and refrigerator.
- LIVING/DINING:** 10'-4" x 14'-6", a large open area with a fireplace, a dining table, and a sofa.
- BATH:** 5'-0" x 7'-6", containing a bathtub, toilet, and sink.
- W/D:** A dedicated laundry room with a washer/dryer area.
- HP:** A small utility or storage room.
- BEDROOM:** 9'-6" x 10'-0", featuring a large bed and a dresser.
- BALCONY:** 9'-10" x 5'-10", located at the bottom of the unit with a railing.
- HWT:** A half-bath or utility room located near the entrance.



THE SOFIA

The Sofia apartments were built in the early 1930s in an Art Deco style with features designed to emphasize the modernity of the parking technology within. The Art Deco movement embraced modernity and the gift of technology. Many of the decorative motifs found on these buildings refer, in some way, to the social advancements offered by technology. An electrical 'parking machine' within the Sofia Apartments towed cars from the elevator platform to the parking spots - this was a technological marvel at the time, (indeed it still is) and was worth celebrating through architectural design.
